

The Reopening Task Force has established new policies for indoor Shabbat morning services ONLY.

We are able to safely accommodate 30 people in the sanctuary on Shabbat morning.

Please read carefully.

We strongly request that all who attend in-person services and other TBI-sponsored events be vaccinated and have the appropriate boosters if they are medically able to do so (with the understanding that children under age 5 are not currently eligible).

For those who are unvaccinated: The following two policies apply for indoor Shabbat morning services. (These two policies do NOT apply to other services)

- *Unvaccinated children under 5 years of age may attend.*
- *Unvaccinated adults and children over 5 must show proof of a negative rapid COVID test taken within 24 hours of attending the service or a negative PCR test taken no more than 48 hours prior to attending. (Rapid tests will be available at TBI for unvaccinated people who do not have access to testing. You may ask the caretaker on duty for a test.)*

For Everyone:

- We require all who attend in-person to follow TBI's guidelines regarding masking. Those who do not will be asked to leave.
- Walk ins are generally not allowed unless there is space. Walk ins will be admitted based on the discretion of staff and ushers.
- **If you signed up but need to cancel:** please remove your name from the signup so others may attend. To do this, follow these steps: 1) Open the Sign Up Confirmation email you received after you signed up. 2) Go to the bottom of that email and click on the light gray text that says "Edit My Sign Up." 3) Click the big Delete button to remove your name. 4) It will ask you to confirm that you want to delete your sign up. Click the "Yes-Delete" button.

If you are feeling unwell, we ask that you please stay home.
