

The Reopening Task Force has updated guidelines for: indoor Shabbat services, outdoor services and events, Talmud Torah teachers and mentors, and B'nai Mitzvah services.

Updated Policies for Indoors:

- For all indoor services and events: All attendees must wear masks covering the nose and mouth. Those who do not will be asked to leave.
 - **For Friday night:**
 - Sign up is no longer required.
 - Proof of vaccination OR proof of medical exemption from a licensed medical doctor required *at the door*.
 - Unvaccinated adults and children over 5 must show proof of a negative rapid COVID test taken within 24 hours prior to attending the service or a negative PCR test taken no more than 48 hours prior to attending. (Rapid tests will be available at TBI for unvaccinated people who do not have access to testing. You may ask the caretaker on duty for a test.)
 - Seating will be distanced and capacity limited to allow for people to spread out.
 - **For Shabbat morning:**
 - Sign up is no longer required.
 - We strongly request that all who attend in-person services and other TBI-sponsored events be vaccinated and have the appropriate boosters if they are medically able to do so (with the understanding that children under age 5 are not currently eligible).
 - For those who are *unvaccinated*: The following two policies apply for indoor Shabbat morning services.
 - Unvaccinated children under 5 years of age may attend.
 - Unvaccinated adults and children over 5 must show proof of a negative rapid COVID test taken within 24 hours of attending the service or a negative PCR test taken no more than 48 hours prior to attending. (Rapid tests will be available at TBI for unvaccinated people who do not have access to testing. You may ask the caretaker on duty for a test.)

Updated Policies for Outdoors:

- For outdoor services and events: Masks are not required.

Updated Policies for Talmud Torah:

- For teachers and mentors: Medical exemptions from a licensed medical doctor are allowed for those who cannot be vaccinated. Documentation of exemption must be provided to Rabbi Solomon prior to beginning in-person contact with students and staff.
- A weekly covid test for unvaccinated teachers is required, and TBI will provide the test. Results of test should be given to Rabbi Solomon.

Updated Policies for Talmud Torah Boker Tov Adult Lounge – TBI Front Lobby Open During Talmud Torah

- After drop off at the north/Talmud Torah/Preschool door, vaccinated adults* (or those with proof of medical exemption from a licensed medical doctor)* may come through the building to

the TBI main entryway lobby. You will see draping (imagine a VIP area). This area is sectioned off and available for adults to hang out and socialize.

- Drinks are permitted, but masks need to stay on while not drinking.
- No food please.
- **Prior to entering the Boker Tov Lounge, please send proof of vaccination OR proof of medical exemption from a licensed medical doctor to talmudtorah@tbieugene.org.*

Updated Policies for B'nai Mitzvah Services:

- Food—kiddush or a full luncheon—is allowed outside in the ohel.
- For indoor services:
 - All attendees must wear masks covering the nose and mouth. Those who do not will be asked to leave.
 - For attendees 5 and up, proof of vaccination OR proof of a negative covid test for those who are not vaccinated (for whatever reason) is required at the door.
 - Children under 5 are allowed at the service.
